

# Gobhi sarson (*Brassica napus* L.)

Nomenclature: (KGS-32) ; Proposed Name: **Shalimar Gobhi Sarson-1**

*“Gobhi sarson variety for Kashmir ; Better in oil quality compared to Brown sarson”*



- Ease of Seed Production on account of its often-cross pollinated nature.
- Early maturing, high yielding (12.5 q/ha) with superiority of 15.40% over the check (*Shalimar Sarson-1*)
- Recommended for low to mid altitudes: 1500-1800m amsl.
- Oil content: 39.03% across locations
- Resistant to Alternaria Blight, Powdery mildew and moderately resistant to Aphids
- B:C Ratio of 1: 2.0 against 1: 1.44 (check)
