Subject: Constitution of a Committee for Determination of Programme-wise Maximum Intake Capacity of Existing Master's and Ph.D Degree Programmes -reg.

In order to bring about uniformity, transparency and consistency in determination of intake capacity of the existing Master's and Ph.D degree programmes of the University, and to establish programme-wise benchmark intake based on the academic and physical resources available, sanction is hereby accorded to the constitution of the following Committee:

Terms of Reference

The Committee shall:

- Examine all the existing Master's and Ph.D degree programmes presently being offered by the University and assess the adequacy of the academic and physical resources available for each programme.
- Verify, *inter-alia*, the availability and adequacy of:
 - Physical infrastructure;
 - Laboratory facilities;
 - Classrooms and teaching infrastructure;
 - Faculty strength in accordance with the prescribed norms;
 - Research facilities, farms/fields and other academic support infrastructure; and
 - Any other infrastructure or academic requirement considered essential under the applicable statutory provisions and University regulations.
- Determine and recommend the maximum permissible intake capacity (upper cap) for each academic programme, taking into consideration the available faculty strength, research supervision capacity, infrastructure and other relevant academic parameters.
- Submit its programme-wise recommendations to the Competent Authority for consideration and approval.
- Recommend, wherever considered necessary, any other measures for ensuring that the intake capacity of academic programmes remains commensurate with the academic resources available in the concerned Division/Faculty.

The recommendations of the Committee, after approval by the Competent Authority, shall constitute the approved maximum intake capacity for the respective academic programmes and shall serve as the reference for notifying student intake in future admission notifications. The actual intake notified for any admission cycle may be less

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than the approved maximum intake, depending upon the requirements and availability communicated by the concerned Division. However, no intake in excess of the approved maximum shall be notified unless the revised intake is approved by the competent statutory authority on the recommendations of the Committee.

The committee shall submit its recommendations expeditiously.
