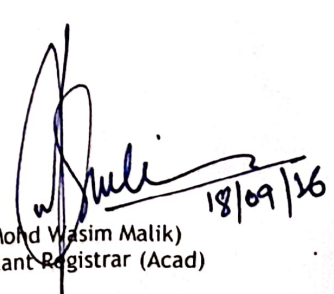
- The participating scholars shall submit a detailed report, duly authenticated by the host institution, to the concerned HoD/Dean within 15 days of their return.
